Treasurer's Report

All is quiet on the financial front as we head towards the Branch Christmas Lunch.

All monies for that are in, and I will be shortly have the final account from the Hotel.

We all know the saying "Fings ain't what they used to be", and we can relate that to many experiences in our own lives. We opened our account with Lloyds Bank when the Branch was formed in 2008. Since then, we have enjoyed free banking, but that is about to change. In January 2025 we will have a chargeable Community account for non-profit organisations with a turnover of less than £250,000 per year: the nearest we come to that figure is £8,400 money in/out. in 2017/18, the year of our 50th Anniversary of withdrawal event, and £7,500 for our 55th event. Based on our last years' figures, I estimate that we will be paying around £100 per annum in bank charges. On the 15th November 2024 our bank balance was £4,450.90, so whilst bank

charges are always unwelcome, we are in an excellent position as we go forward into the next period of the Branch's history.

On 14th November at Cheltenham Crematorium, Rick and I said farewell to Tommy Clough, a Korean War Veteran. Tommy was well known to most of us, following a presentation he gave on the 15th Anniversary of our Branch formation.

Tommy was an Artillery Boy Entrant and started his army career at Woolwich Barracks aged 14!!

In 1951 he was posted to Korea and attached to the Gloster Regiment. He was captured by the Chinese along with some Gloster boys at the Battle of Imjin River.

He was in captivity for nearly three years escaping twice, which cost him dearly, receiving severe punishment for his escapades.

Tommy's first association with the Aden Veterans was participating in the Joining Forces Project collaboration with Gloucestershire University, creating eight Veterans Stories as videos on CD disc. AVA participants were, Sally Welzel, Rick Rutter, Chris Blick, Denis Sparrow, Brian "Padre" Woollaston and yours truly. Emlyn Phennah.

Tommy's Wake was held in the Warrant Officers and Sergeants mess in Imjin Barracks. His final accolade being, one of the Bars in the mess being named as the "Tommy Clough Bar
